Did/do you have a washing machine in your home?			
How much water does your home use in a day?			
Why is it important to protect water?			

We are asking schools to submit their findings, what are the biggest changes and how has the value of water changed? The information showing how water matters at home have changed for your pupils and their families in the past 50 years can be submitted as:

- a poster with all the facts and figures, pictures, maps etc
- a story describing the changes
- a picture drawn by a pupil or a class group
- a video to describe the changes
